Personal Safety: Be aware of your surroundings. Know traffic flow direction; location of road cones, barrels, and barricades. Know where the curbs and any manhole covers are located.

Equipment Safety: When backing, truck drivers should stop if they lose sight of the signal/dump person. **Site Safety:** Be aware of the "Big 4" construction hazards: Falls, Caught-In or -Between, **Struck-By**, and Electrocution.

Struck-By

- 1. Struck-by hazard categories: Flying, falling, swinging and rolling objects.
- 2. Equipment operators have limited or no visibility when operating in reverse. Maintain your situational awareness when working around mobile equipment.
- 3. Guard areas where material may fall from bins or equipment.
- 4. Make sure equipment is rated for weight to be lifted. Never walk under suspended loads.
- 5. Always wear eye, face, and head protection when using power tools or working near them
